### **Important Instructions for CBSE Class 10, 12 Board Exam 2023**

Students will be subjected to extensive and compulsory physical frisking before entering the examination centre.

1. Candidates must report to their respective exam centre dressed in their proper **blue school uniform, with their CBSE admit card 2023 and valid school ID card.**
2. Candidates are required to read and follow the crucial guidelines on the admit card.
3. Candidates must ensure appropriate travel plans based on the weather, traffic and other important aspects that may affect their travelling to the exam centre on time.
4. To ensure reaching the exam centre on time for the exam, candidates are advised to visit the exam centre a day before the examination starts.
5. After 10:00 am, no candidate would be permitted to enter the testing

location. So, you must arrive on time.

## **PERMITTED ITEMS**

- Stationery item i.e., Transparent Pouch, Geometry/Pencil Box, Blue/Royal Blue Ink/Ball Point/Gel Pen, Scale, Writing Pad, Eraser, Analogue Watch, Trans-parent Water Bottles and Hand Sanitizer 50 ml.
- Metro Card, Bus Pass.

## **BARRED ITEMS**

- Any stationery item – such as textual material (printed or written), bits of papers, Calculator, Pen Drives, Log Table (shall be provided by the centres), Electronic Pen/ Scanner, etc.
- Any communication device – such as Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Earphones, Microphone, Pager, Health Band, Camera, etc.
- Other items like Wallet, Goggles, Handbags, pouches, etc.
- Any eatable item opened or packed, except for diabetic students.
- Any other item which could be used for unfair means.
- Use of above or similar items will be treated under “Unfair Means” category and will attract punishment as per rules.
